The Paul Jones Goalkeeping Academy program was officially launched in May 1987 and since then has been working with many talented goalkeepers throughout the state, placing them in a professional training environment. Paul Jones Goalkeeping has produced more than 22 international goalkeepers and currently has 7 goalkeepers signed with A-League clubs around Australia.

The Paul Jones Goalkeeping Academy program covers all aspects of the goalkeeping position including areas such as technical, tactical, psychological, nutrition, strength and conditioning just to name a few. No stone is left unturned by the Academy staff to help goalkeepers that are serious about improving their game.

Paul Jones Goalkeeping will assist dedicated players that have the desire and ambition to improve and have the dedication and conviction to want to establish and achieve goals.

Academy Director & Head Coach Paul Jones

Paul Jones is a former Under 23 and Young Socceroo international goalkeeper who has been a specialised goalkeeping coach for more than 23 years Based in Canberra Paul Jones has worked with junior and senior goalkeepers from club level to international level.

Paul's coaching experience started in 1987 then moved to the position of Australian Institute of Sport goalkeeper coach in 1987. This was a position that Paul held for more than 20 years before moving to England. On his return he was drafted straight back into the position of national coach for women football.

Since 1987 more than 22 goalkeepers coached by Paul have gone on to represent their country both in men and women's football. In addition to this since Paul left the Australian Institute of Sport Paul has had 4 goalkeepers move from local league competition to train with the AIS. Currently there are 7 goalkeepers coached by Paul that are signed with A-League clubs.

The Paul Jones has produced 22 International goalkeepers, most recently Mitch Langerak (Borussia Dortmund) & Adam Federici (Reading UK) Socceroos squad and Lydia Williams (Matilda's, Young Matilda's) Casey Dumont (Matilda's, Young Matilda's, Junior Matilda's) and Breanne Davis (Young Matilda's Matilda's), as well as Canberra girl Georgina Worth (Junior Matilda's).



Paul Jones is currently one of 4 National Goalkeeping Coaches and in the past 5 years has worked with the Matilda's (FIFA 2007 & 2011 Women's World Cup, AFC Championship 2006, 2008 & 2010 Asian Champions). Former exclusive goalkeeper coach for all national women's teams, Matilda's, Young Matildas and Junior Matilda's goalkeepers (under 17's).

This experience and the ability to liaise with national coaches allows Paul and the other Academy coaches keep up with the latest coaching developments from around the world which can then be integrated into the Paul Jones Goalkeeping Academy program ensuring that goalkeepers in the program are at the forefront of international goalkeeping trends.
